Membership Terms and Agreement

CANCELLATION: Should a member choose to cancel their membership, he or she must submit a request in writing to the General Manager containing member information and cancellation date. If the cancellation request comes prior to the end of the member's 12 month agreement, a cancellation fee (equal to three (3) monthly payments) will be charged to the members account. Prepaid members will be issued a refund should their prepaid amount exceed the cancellation fee.

REFUSAL OF PRIVILEGE: Stonebridge Golf Club shall have the right to refuse golf course privileges to anyone who is judged to be in violation of the established rules and regulations herein. *Stonebridge Golf Club shall have the right to suspend or revoke a members privilege if course policies are repeatedly broken.*

REGISTRATION: All golfers must register and sign in at the golf shop before play. Members are required to show their Membership Card (which is non-transferable). Cart not included.

DRESS CODE: Golfers are expected to wear traditional golf attire on the course. Stonebridge Golf Club is a non-metal spike facility.

PACE OF PLAY: All Membership Holders are expected to abide by the pace of play policies instituted by the Stonebridge Golf Club Management. Players are expected to play in 4 hours and 30 minutes or less.

COURTEOUS PLAY: It is golfing etiquette to replace divots, repair ball marks on greens, rake smooth all marks made in sand traps and remove used tees from the teeing grounds. Please assist us in the upkeep of the course and encourage your guests to do likewise.

GOLF CARTS: Cart rules will be posted daily in the Golf Shop and all players are expected to abide by these rules. Carts must be driven on cart paths only on all Par 3's and kept at least 30 feet from all Tees and Greens at all times. Roped off areas are off limits to carts. Players must pair up on carts. No single carts will be permitted in twosome or foursomes.

FOOD & BEVERAGE: Food and beverages are not permitted on the course unless purchased from Stonebridge Golf Club. Snack Bar items may be purchased from the Golf Shop or the beverage cart on the golf course. Private coolers are not permitted. Players will be refused play and the privileges will be lost if any policies stated herein are not adhered to.

LIMITATION OF LIABILITY: Stonebridge Golf Club will not be liable for any lost profits or for any indirect, incidental, consequential, punitive or other special damages suffered by the player arising out of or related to this Agreement even if Stonebridge Golf Club has been advised of the possibility of such damages. In no event shall the total cumulative liability of Stonebridge Golf Club in connection with the Agreement from all causes of action of any kind (including tort, contract negligence, strict liability, breach warranty and fundamental breach) exceed the total amount paid by the player to Stonebridge Golf Club under this Agreement.
